- Accomplished faculty researchers have published hundreds of studies and reports in top academic journals, authored dozens of books and made presentations at major conferences around the globe
- Research collaborations with many public and private sector partners result in indepth analyses that inform decision-making on a broad range of topics
- Ph.D. program in Public Policy and Administration includes a strong research component; master's and undergraduate students in a range of disciplines work with faculty on policy-related research
- Programs such as the annual Frank Church Institute Conference, the Western Energy Policy Research
 Conference, the Fettuccine Forum and seminars of the Andrus Center for Public Policy engage the public
 and diverse stakeholders on policy issues and encourage thoughtful dialogue
